Application for Entry to Year 10 2026

Entry to Years 8-12 is dependent upon vacancies. Historically, there have been very few, if any, vacancies in Year 10.

Selection Criteria

Students selected for enrolment at SBHS are expected to support and enhance the ethos of the school in its pursuit of academic excellence, through its competition in the AAGPS and by participation in a range of co-curricular activities.

The Selection Committee considers:

- the educational history of the student
- his performance in academic competitions
- his sporting interests and accomplishments
- his co-curricular interests and abilities
- his reasons for wishing to attend SBHS
- the availability of subjects/courses or combinations of these
- his proximity and ease of access to the school
- compassionate circumstances
- whether he has siblings already enrolled in the school
- · his desire to access single sex education
- the impact on local public comprehensive schools
- the effects on local area selective classes in comprehensive schools

Family Placement Claim

Where two or more boys have equal merit, a boy with a family placement claim will be given priority. A family placement claim can be made if a brother or sister, parent, grandparent, guardian or caregiver currently attends or previously attended Sydney Boys High School or Sydney Girls High School. Sons or Grandsons of Old Boys may be invited to sit the school's Placement Tests.

The Application and Selection Process

Please complete the four pages of this application form. Supply a copy of your last two School Reports. Do not supply any other documents. Once the application form is submitted, it cannot be altered and you cannot add another report to the application. If you are selected for interview you will be required to support your claims with appropriate evidence. Return your application, accompanied by a non-refundable payment of \$105 to cover administration costs (processing and assessment of application), to the school by 3:00pm on Friday 25 July 2025.

Applications will be considered by the *Selection Committee*. The *Selection Committee* is chaired by the Principal. Representatives from the P&C and SHSOBU are invited to assist in the selection process. A Deputy Principal is a member of the Committee. The initial assessment of applications may be made by a large sub-committee of the Selection Committee, comprising Teacher Assessors, trained in the assessment procedures applied under the local selection policy. Each application is assessed at least twice and the Assessors' scores are tallied and recorded. Once a rank order list is created, the Committee decides on the number of suitable applicants. These applicants are then short-listed and invited to sit the School's Placement Tests. Interviews are then arranged for the number of vacancies available, plus a number of Reserves, determined by the Committee.

Applicants short-listed must attend the school's Placement Test consisting of a range of literacy and numeracy tasks set by the School, to be held on **Monday 11 August 2025 from 4:30-5:40pm in the School's Great Hall**. At this stage, Placement Test results, the applicant's abilities, interests and achievements are taken into consideration, including their academic and post-school aspirations, their 'fit' with the school's ethos in terms of their co-curricular and sporting activities, their demonstrated commitment to the values of the school, appropriate course vacancies and the validity, accuracy and quality of their accompanying documentation. At the conclusion of the process, the Principal recommends the revised rank order list to the Selection Committee Members and a final rank order list is completed. The rank order lists are shared with the community member for review and comment. As a result of the school's application and testing process, short-listed applicants may be invited for interview.

If vacancies exist, a *Placement List* is created and applicants are offered places. A *Reserve List* for future vacancies is created as a result of a different process. Ranked scores from the School's Placement Tests, held before interview, are used to determine any remaining vacancies. As vacancies arise, applicants are contacted and places are offered. The *Reserve List* is current until the application process for the following year commences in June. Successful applicants are either offered places or advised of their position on the Reserve List.

Curriculum for Year 10 students 2026

Boys at Sydney Boys High School study: English, Mathematics, Science, PD/Health/PE, and Careers Education. Boys also select **three elective subjects** from: Chinese, Classical Greek, Commerce, Computing Technology (Game Design), Computing Technology (Mechatronics), Design and Technology, Drama, French, Geography, German, Graphics Technology, History, Japanese, Latin, Music, Physical Activity & Sport Studies, Photographic & Digital Media, Visual Arts and Visual Design.
